AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 10.01.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No.28972 of 2017. Operational part of the order is reproduced below:-

“5. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Divisional Excise & Taxation Commissioner, Jalandhar Divison, Jalandhar, Punjab to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated April 12, 2017 (P-2) and take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order that too, after giving a patience hearing to the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

6. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, she shall be at liberty to approach this Court.”

Learned counsel for the respondent has filed the reply annexing order dated 29.08.2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that retiral benefits have been granted and only the issue with regard to interest on delayed payment survives. He states that petitioner be granted liberty to avail remedies for the said grievance.

In view of order dated 29.08.2018 of the Deputy Excise and Taxation Commissioner, Amritsar, the contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous. Rule issued against the respondents is discharged.

In case of grievance, petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.
