AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 20.11.2017 passed in CRM-M No.43915 of 2017.

The issue is with regard to payment of maintenance. It was ordered that the husband shall continue to pay amount assessed under the proceedings of Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005. There is no dispute between the parties that ₹15,000/- per month is to be paid.

On notice, Sh. Mahesh Chadha (respondent) is present in the Court and verified by his counsel. He made a statement that he would, henceforth, make payment of ₹15,000/- per month

regularly. He has filed an affidavit today in the Court mentioning details of his bank account which is in the name of his shop. The account is with ICICI Bank, Sector 22, Chandigarh. He undertakes that ₹15,000/- shall be paid directly in the bank account of petitioner-wife on or before 7th of every month. The affidavit is taken on record, copy is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

The RTGS details of bank account of petitioner-wife has been handed over to the respondent-husband. At this stage, he undertakes that he will instruct his banker i.e. ICICI Bank that RTGS of ₹15,000/- would be made on or before 7th of every month.

In view of said affidavit and statement made, the contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.

However, to ensure the compliance, copy of this order be sent to the Branch Manager, ICICI Bank, Sector 22, Chandigarh. The bank shall ensure that minimum balance of ₹15,000/- is maintained over and above minimum balance to be maintained in the account to ensure that payment is made to the respondent-wife, well in time.
