Costs of Rs.10,000/- imposed on respondent No.2 vide order dated 5.2.2019 has been paid.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in view of affidavit filed though certain amounts have been paid to the petitioners but the amount is not correctly calculated. He states that no detailed computation has been provided.

Learned counsel for respondent No.1 submits that the calculation of the amount shall be provided within four weeks from today.

In view of above, the contempt petition is disposed of. For the grievance of the petitioners with regard to amount calculated, they shall file a representation with their own detailed calculation, the same shall be considered by respondents in accordance with law, after affording

opportunity of hearing. The needful shall be done expeditiously, in case any amount is found due, the same be paid immediately thereafter.
