This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of orders dated 12.02.2018 and 12.03.2018 passed in CWP No. 29910 of 2017.

Learned State counsel has filed a short reply by way of an affidavit of Sh. Suresh Arora, IPS, Director General of Police, Punjab annexing the order dated 26.07.2018, same are taken on record. Copy handed over to counsel for the petitioners.

In view of order dated 26.07.2018, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law against the order annexed with the reply.
