The present petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 16.01.2018 passed in CWP No. 707 of 2018.

The operational part of the order is quoted below:-

“ Keeping in view the submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner and also that other similarly situated persons have filed petition and their petition has been disposed of with a direction to consider their representation, the present petition is also disposed of with a direction to respondent Nos.3 & 4 to consider the pending representation of the petitioner dated 12.01.2017 (Annexure P-7) and pass speaking order in accordance with law within a period of two months from date of receipt of certified copy of the order.”

Learned State counsel has filed an affidavit of Rishi Kumar, Assistant Registrar, Co-operative Societies, Gurugram annexing the order dated 21.08.2019. Copy handed over to the counsel for the petitioner.

In view of reply filed, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that no cause of action survives for pursuing the present petition, however, she seeks liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law against the order dated 21.08.2019.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondents stand discharged.
