Learned counsel for the petitioner, candidly, submits that arrears from 01.02.2005 have been paid. The grievance is that the services were regularized from 01.10.2003. He further submits that the detailed calculations have not been provided.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr. Udayvir Jhaghria, XEN, PD-1, PWD (B&R), Rohtak, argues that the petitioner was absent from duty from 01.10.2003 to 01.02.2005 for which the proposal has been sent to the competent authority to treat the same for Extra Ordinary Leave. He further submits that the detailed calculations would be provided to the petitioner within four weeks from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement made today in Court, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition. However, seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law, if aggrieved of the calculations and for the period for which the petitioner has been treated absent from duty.

Disposed of with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondents is discharged.
