AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 12.03.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No.5943 of 2018.

The relevant portion of the order is reproduced below:-

“In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Director General of Police, Punjab, Deluxe Building, Mini Secretariat, Punjab, Sector-9, Chandigarh to consider and decide the legal notice dated 24.01.2018 (Annexure P-7) within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within

a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.”

Reply dated 21.11.2018 was filed annexing order dated 19.11.2018. The petitioner filed rejoinder which was taken on record.

The grievance raised is that in the legal notice, seniority and promotion was sought with effect from the date on which his batch mates namely Inspector Amar Singh 219/FDK, Inspector Jaswinder Pal 556/FDK, Inspector Darshan Singh 1135/FDK, Inspector Kulwant Rai 114/FZR and Inspector Gurbhej Singh 448/FZR were promoted. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that while passing the order, some other batch mates have been considered instead of one named officer in representation.

Learned State counsel states that fresh order will be passed within eight weeks from today after providing opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

In view of statement made, the contempt petition is disposed of.

Since the main case has been disposed of, the pending application has been rendered infructuous.
