Dharmender Singh, Administrator, HSVP, Faridabad on behalf of the
respondent is sought to be placed on record.

Allowed as prayed for. Reply is taken on record.

COCP No.1999 of 2018

The present contempt petition has been filed for non-
compliance of the order dated 24.01.2018, vide which a direction was
issued to the respondent to decide the representation of the petitioner, in
accordance with law by passing a speaking order and after affording an
opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

As per the aforesaid reply, the case of the petitioner was
considered by way of passing of a speaking order dated 18.10.2018, vide
which the petitioner is found entitled for an alternative plot of an ordinary

location as per policy with a further observation that additional amount shall be charged for special category plot.

In view of the same, no contempt is made.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that whatever be, the plot has still not been handed over.

This Court has no doubt that in pursuance of the speaking order passed, the respondent shall take the relief/matter to its logical conclusion by handing over the plot to the petitioner within two months from today.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed.
