The petitioner filed a writ petition aggrieved of issuance of two charge-sheets long after his retirement. Earlier six charge-sheets were issued which were quashed. The writ petition was allowed and the impugned charge-sheet was quashed and it was ordered that pensionary benefits of the petitioner be restored and arrears be paid within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of order. Interest @ 6% per annum was awarded from 36 months prior to institution of the petition till the date of realization.

The present petition is filed pleading that needful has not been done by the respondents.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Ms. Gurjit Kaur, Senior Assistant, O/o Department of Water Resources, Punjab, submits that the pensionary benefits have been restored, arrears paid except for interest for some period. It is stated that interest would be credited to the account of the petitioner within two months from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that amount found due have not been correctly calculated. The said aspect cannot be gone into in the present contempt petition.

The contempt petition is disposed of in view of statement made by learned State counsel.

However, the respondents are directed to provide details of calculation of amount found due to the petitioner within six weeks from today. In case there is any grievance with regard to calculation of amount, the petitioner shall be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law for redressal of the surviving grievance.

As the main case has been disposed of, pending civil miscellaneous applications has been rendered infructuous.
