The petition filed by the petitioner for re-determining the petitioner's compensation/benefit under the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 was disposed of on the statement made by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is ready and willing to take the land back in case it is formally released and possession delivered.

Thereafter, learned counsel for respondents submitted that petitioner may apply for alternative piece of land which shall be allotted to him at a better location after examining the application. This Court directed that if an application is filed within fifteen days, a speaking order shall be passed and the petitioner would be handed over the possession of land at a better location within one month. For non-compliance of the said order, the present contempt petition has been filed.

Pursuant to notice of motion, reply was filed annexing the agreement and memo dated 10.5.2019. As per the agreement there was an exchange of land, thereafter land measuring 400 square yard in rakba of Patti Musalman in Killa No.4611 had been allotted to the petitioner but the mutation has not been sanctioned till date.

Learned counsel for respondents states that delay was caused as there was an interim order in favour of the party who was in possession of the said land. The said litigation has ended now and the mutation has been sanctioned in favour of HSVP, he states that needful for sanctioning mutation in favour of petitioner will be done within two weeks.

In view of the aforesaid statement, the contempt petition is disposed of.
