The application is allowed. Documents i.e. annexures P-3 to P-8 are taken on record.

COCP-2012-2018

The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of the order dated 12.3.2018.

Reply is filed. As per the said reply, the order has been complied with. The amount due to the petitioner has been paid.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, states that no interest has been paid whereas as per the speaking order, the respondents have given a detail of the time consumed for disbursing the pensionary benefits to the petitioner showing that there is no delay. With respect to the delay for releasing the gratuity, it is stated that the petitioner was

required to submit his papers much prior to his retirement which he did not do. Hence, there is no delay on their part.

In view of the same, the contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondent(s) is discharged.

However, in case the petitioner is still aggrieved in passing of the speaking order dated 3.7.2018 in any manner, he is at liberty to challenge the same order in accordance with law.
