**AVNEESH JHINGAN, J. (Oral)**

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 10.1.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 27139 of 2017. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

*“3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated July 05, 2017 (P-1) and take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order that too, after giving a patience hearing to the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.”*

Learned counsel for the respondent has produced order dated 14.8.2019 in court today. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the order passed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition, however, he seeks liberty to avail remedies available in accordance with law against the order.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
