The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 22.11.2017 passed in CWP No. 26428 of 2017.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr. Paramjit Singh, PCS, Deputy Director (Admn.), Department of Social Justice & Empowerment, Punjab, submits that for complying the directions of this Court dated 22.11.2017, opinion was sought from the Legal Remembrancer, Punjab and after receiving the opinion, it has been decided that the benefit is to be granted as per the decision of this Court rendered in CWP No. 2371 of 2010, titled as **Harbans Lal vs. State of Punjab**; decided on 31.08.2010. It is further submitted that the needful would be done within 8 weeks from today.

In view of above, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition.

In view of above, the petition is disposed of.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.

It is made clear that in case the afore-said statement is not adhered to, petitioners would be at liberty to revive the present contempt petition.
