The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of order dated 5.8.2015 passed in CWP No. 2867 of 2015.

The issue arises from the directions issued by this Court in **Tilak Raj Versus The State of Haryana and others** in CWP No. 6090 of 2010.

The grievance raised is that the services of Guest Teachers have not been dispensed with in compliance of **Tilak Raj's case (supra)**.

Learned State counsel relies on Haryana Guest Teachers Service Act, 2019 (Haryana Act No.13 of 2019). As per Section 3 of the Act, the Guest Teacher shall continue till the date of superannuation. He states that the vires of the Act is subject matter of writ petition before this Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that he may be permitted to withdraw the present contempt petition at this stage with liberty to file fresh one if some grievance still survives after decision on the Vires of the Act.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
