This contempt petition has arisen from a litigation in matrimonial dispute. Divorce decree under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 dissolving the marriage was passed on 21.02.2014. The only issue in the present contempt petition is with regard to the custody of son namely Puru.

This Court interacted with the son of the petitioner on 17.11.2018. Today, also he is present in Court and verified by his mother and the counsel for the respondent. There is no dispute on the fact that he has already attained the age of majority and he is not willing to go with his mother.

In view of the said development, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that she may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
