AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

Learned State counsel has filed short reply by way of affidavit of Dr. Balkar Singh, Director Secondary Education, Haryana attaching the detailed calculation, same is taken on record. Copy handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel submits that amount has already been paid and no amount is due as on date.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that calculation of the amount is not correct.

The said aspect cannot be gone into the contempt petition as there is substantial compliance of directions of this Court

to pay the arrears.

The contempt petition is disposed of.

However, if the petitioner moves a representation alongwith his calculation within four weeks, the same shall be considered by the respondents in accordance with law, expeditiously and not later than eight weeks from the date of receipt of representation. The petitioner, if aggrieved of the decision on the representation, shall be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.
