This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 28.2.2018 passed in CWP No. 4878 of 2018.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

"That being so, the petition is disposed of, at this stage, only with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the claim/grievance of the petitioners, as also their legal notice, dated 24.10.2017 (Annexure P-5), within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order. And pass appropriate orders in accordance with law. In the event, the claim of the petitioners is declined, the authority shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof."

Reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Anand Mohan Sharan, Principal Secretary to Govt. Haryana, has been filed today in Court. Copy given to counsel for the petitioners. Along with reply, decision on legal notice is annexed.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is not able to dispute the fact that costs imposed of ₹2000/- for each petitioners has been received by him. He states

that in view of the order passed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
