Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that earlier the petitioner was falsely implicated on the basis of the complaint given by Manpreet Singh, Harpreet Singh, etc. in January, 2017 and now he has been falsely implicated in this case. FIR No.0045 dated 16.7.2018 under Section 307/341/336/148/149 IPC and Section 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Panjtoor, District Moga was recorded on the basis of statement of injured Harpreet Singh with the allegations that the petitioner Amandeep Singh on the date of occurrence stopped him and fired gun shot injury which pierced his thigh through and through. It was also narrated by him in the FIR that previously also, there was a dispute between the parties.

Considering the alleged manner in which the petitioner has caused injury to the injured-complainant Harpreet Singh, no case for grant of extraordinary concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.

The petition is dismissed.
