AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of interim order dated 07.06.2017 passed by this Court in CWP No.13560 of 2017. The directions issued were similar as passed in CWP No.12705 of 2017.

The relevant portion of the order passed in CWP No.12705 of 2017 is reproduced below:-

“In the meantime, it is directed that the petitioners will not be replaced by another set of Adhoc Employees/Contractual Employees/Guest Faculty.”

Pursuant to notice of motion, reply by way of affidavit of

Dr. B.C. Josan, Principal, DAV College, Sector 10, Chandigarh was

filed.

The relevant portion of paragraph 13 is reproduced below:-

“Thus the work has been distributed amongst the 6 permanent teachers. Therefore, no contract appointment has been made in the department of Bio Technology in the place of the petitioners.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of averments made in paragraph 13, he may be permitted to withdraw the present contempt petition.

The contempt petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

The rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
