The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 12.12.2017 passed in CWP No. 28100 of 2017 (which was disposed of in terms of order dated 7.11.2017 passed in CWP No. 25357 of 2017).

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

"In the circumstances, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioners with regard to the regular permit/temporary permit in accordance with the prevailing position of law after considering the effect of the orders of the Supreme Court dated 04.09.2017 and 13.10.2017. The necessary orders be now passed within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order."

Today learned counsel for the respondents has produced reply by way of affidavit of Jagniwas, HCS, Additional Deputy Commissioner-cum-Secretary RTA, Jhajjar. Along with reply, order dated 9.7.2019 has been

annexed. Copy supplied to counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that after passing of the order, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition. He seeks liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law against the order dated 9.7.2019.

Dismissed as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
