The present contempt petitions are filed for non-compliance of the order dated 11.05.2016.

Reply by way of affidavits of Director General Secondary Education Haryana, Panchkula on behalf of respondent No.2 in all cases are filed today in Court. The same are taken on record. Copy given to learned counsel for the petitioners.

As per the said reply, sanction has since been received from the Finance Department and the amount shall soon be disbursed to the petitioners within six weeks from today. Costs too has been paid.

In view of the above, the present contempt petitions are dismissed.

Rule issued against against the respondents stands discharged.

In case the amount is not deposited within the stipulated period as stated above, the petitioners are at liberty to revive the contempt petitions.

In case the petitioners are forced to revive the contempt petitions, the respondents will be liable for penalty.
