The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 17.08.2017 passed by this Court in CWP No. 18094 of 2017. The direction of this Court was to decide the legal notice dated 25.05.2017 within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

Notice of motion was issued on 23.01.2018. As per office, report, process fee has not been filed. Thereafter, on 11.09.2018, learned counsel for the petitioners was instructed to supply the copy of the contempt petition to the learned State counsel for having instructions, even that order was not complied with.

Today none has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioners in spite of two pass overs. Now, a request has been made for an adjournment.

No useful purpose would be served in keeping this contempt

petition pending.

On asking of the Court, learned State counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

The contempt petition is disposed of with the directions that the petitioners would now supply the copy of order dated 17.08.2017 passed in CWP No. 18094 of 2017 alongwith the order passed today.

On doing the needful, the respondent would comply with the directions of this Court within a period of four months from the date of receipt of copies of the orders.

In case, the needful is not done in the specified time, the petitioner would be at liberty to file fresh contempt petition.

Rule issued against the respondent is discharged.
