AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful
disobedience of order dated 16.08.2013 passed by this Court in
CWP No.17707 of 1994.

Reply by way of affidavit of Dr. Vandana Disodia,
Additional Secretary to Government of Haryana, School Education
Department, Panchkula filed today in the Court, is taken on record,
copy handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr. J.S. Gill,
D.D.A., O/o Director Elementary Education, Panchkula submits that
pensionary benefits have been revised and Pension Payment Order
(PPO) already sent to the Treasury. He further states that payment

would be credited in account of the petitioner within three weeks from today and calculation thereof shall be provided to the petitioner within four weeks from today.

In view of statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner states that no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition.

The contempt petition is disposed of.

However, petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law, if aggrieved of said calculation.
