Affidavit of Surinder Kumar, Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Rampura Phul, District Bathinda dated 8.1.2019 has been filed.

It is not disputed that the order to the extent of payment of retiral benefits has since been complied with.

In view of above, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the respondent was also required to pass order on interest part that was claimed in the legal notice. No speaking order has been passed qua the interest.

In view of above, the respondent is directed to pass a speaking order considering the claim of interest within four weeks from today. In case, the petitioner is found entitled to the said interest, the same shall also be paid within another four weeks from the passing of the said order or else the speaking order shall be passed for which the petitioner is at liberty to challenge the same in accordance with law.

Rule issued to the respondent stands discharged.
