The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the orders dated 17.09.2014 and 11.08.2015 passed in Civil Appeal No. 356 of 2014.

In compliance of the order dated 03.07.2019 passed by this Court, the then Deputy Commissioner is present in Court today and states that it was only in due process that the application reached at his level and police help was provided to maintain law and order situation only. His explanation is accepted.

The issue is with regard to violation of *status quo*.

Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that the proceedings

under Section 7 of The Punjab Village Common Land Act, 1961 are pending

and the learned counsel for respondent No.1 submits that he has instructions to make statement that in case the petitioner will be dispossessed in accordance with law, if need so arise only.

In view of above, the present contempt petition is disposed of.

The Rule issued against the respondents is discharged.
