The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of order dated 22.05.2017.

Compliance report by way of affidavit of respondent No.3 filed in Court is taken on record. Copy given to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute that the order has been complied with substantially as it is evident from the said compliance report.

However, learned counsel for respondent No.3 states that the entire amount due to the petitioner stands paid.

In view of the same, the present contempt petition is dismissed.
