Present petition under Section 439 of the Criminal Procedure Code has been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.434 dated 17.11.2017 under Sections 307, 452, 34 of the Indian Penal Code (for short, 'IPC') read with Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Hathin, District Palwal.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner contended that the main injury, attracting provisions of Section 307 IPC, has not been attributed to the petitioner and the allegations qua him are regarding his presence on the spot only. The petitioner is in custody since 05.04.2018 and no useful purpose would be served by detaining him behind the bar, so he be released on bail.

Learned State counsel, while opposing the prayer for bail, fairly conceded that the main injury, attracting provisions of Section 307 IPC, has not been attributed to the petitioner and the allegations qua him are regarding his presence on the spot.

Taking all the facts into consideration and the fact that the main injury, attracting provisions of Section 307 IPC, has not been attributed to the petitioner and he is alleged to have been present at the spot, the petitioner is otherwise in custody since 05.04.2018, trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bar any more, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be admitted on regular bail on furnishing adequate bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned learned trial Judge/ Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate.
