This contempt petition arise for non-compliance of order dated 05.07.2017 in CWP No. 14132 of 2017 read with order dated 08.03.2017 passed in CWP No. 4736 of 2017. The writ petition was disposed of on the statement made by the learned counsel for the HUDA (now known as Haryana Shahari Vikas Pradhikaran) that the order dated 08.03.2017 in CWP No. 4736 of 2017 was to be complied with latest by 31.07.2017.

Pursuant to the notice of motion, a reply was filed annexing order dated 12.09.2017 wherein the claim of the petitioner with regard to the allotment of plot was decided.

The grievance raised by the petitioner was that no order has been passed with regard to the interest to be paid on the earnest money.

Today in Court, a short reply by way of an affidavit of Sh. Yogesh Ranga, Estate Officer, HSVP Karnal has been filed, same is taken on record and a copy is handed over to learned counsel for the

petitioner. Along with reply, order dated 22.08.2019 has been annexed whereby the claim of the petitioner, seeking interest on earnest money, has been rejected.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail his remedies in accordance with law against order dated 22.08.2019.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against respondents is discharged.
