The appeal filed by the petitioners before the Educational Tribunal, Punjab, was allowed on 12.12.2017. It was ordered that the petitioners would be adjusted against the aided posts. The policy considering the petitioners as fresh appointees was set aside. The respondents were directed to recalculate the salary payable to petitioners by including their past services. The arrears were to be paid within four months from receipt of the certified copy of order failing which interest @ 6% per annum was to be granted.

The present contempt petition has been filed stating that the directions of the Tribunal have not been complied with.

Reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Karandeep Singh Cheema, Joint Secretary, Sikh Educational Society, has been filed today and the same is taken on record. Copy supplied to counsel for petitioners.

As per the reply filed, the amounts have been calculated and

paid to petitioners. Copies of the cheques are also annexed.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that no detailed calculation have been provided *in spite* of specifically demanding the same.

Learned counsel for respondents states that detailed calculation would be provided within three weeks from today.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is disposed of.

Needless to say that in case there is any grievance with regard to calculation of amount, the petitioners shall be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law. In case the calculations are not provided, the petitioners would be at liberty to revive the contempt petition.

In view of the fact that the main petition has been disposed of, the pending civil miscellaneous application has been rendered infructuous.
