Learned counsel for the petitioners states that though the direction of this Court vide order dated 28.2.2017 passed in CWP No. 20584 of 2015 has been complied with. However, he states that qua petitioner No.6- Gurmail Singh an amount of ₹12,68,028/- odd has been deducted on the ground that the amount was received earlier, the fact is disputed. He states that petitioners have moved a representation and respondents be directed to decide the representation expeditiously. He further states that Assured Career Progression has not been granted to the petitioners. He seeks liberty to avail remedy for redressal of the said grievance.

Learned State counsel states that the representation if received or moved now would be decided expeditiously as possible.

In view of above, the contempt petition is disposed of with liberty as prayed for.
