FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (Oral)

Report dated 04.10.2019 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class has been received whereby after recording statements of petitioners Sombir and Raju son of Suresh, who is also known as Rajesh as has been stated by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Bhupender Singh, Police Station Salhawas, District Jhajjar, which fact is well demonstrated in the FIR as well and complainant Mona, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and the fact that the offences for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**' **2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543** and '**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**' **2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 135 dated 06.06.2015 registered at Police Station Salhawas, District Jhajjar under Sections 354-B, 451, 323, 506 and 34 IPC and all the consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
