Present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner claiming the re-fixation of his pay in view of the orders of this Court passed in CWP No.16084 of 1997 and CWP No. 2757 of 1998, which were upheld by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, vide order dated 08.12.2015 (Annexure P-5) in Civil Appeal No. 8661 of 2009.

Petitioner claim that he is similarly situated with those who have been granted the relief by this Court but the same has not been granted to him only on the ground that he has approached this Court and was not the petitioner in above mentioned writ petitions.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case, a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide the representation dated 05.08.2018 (Annexure P-7).

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. C.S. Bakhshi, Additional

Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and states that he has no objection to the prayer of the petitioner for deciding his representation dated 05.08.2018 (Annexure P-7) at this stage.

Keeping in view the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and entitlement of the petitioner in respect of the claim made in the writ petition/representation, the respondents are directed to decide the representation dated 05.08.2018 (Annexure P-7) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any relief, the same shall also be released to him within a period of next three months.

Present writ petition stands disposed of .
