However, in case the said amount due to the petitioner is not deposited within four weeks from today, the petitioners will be at liberty to revive the contempt petition and in case they are forced to revive the same,

respondent-University shall be liable to pay heavy penalty which would be

personally recoverable from the concerned Officer.

Since the main case has been dismissed, all the pending applications have become infructuous and the same are disposed of as such.
