The petitioner was appointed as Helper Grade-II on 17.01.1992 in Haryana State Electricity Board. Thereafter he was allocated to the Uttar Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam Limited. The petitioner was entitled for the pay scale of ₹1200-2040 being matric with ITI and was working on the technical post. The petitioner along with other persons approached this Court by way of ***CWP-2060-2011 Shamsher Singh and others V/s. U.H.B.V.N and others***, which was allowed on 23.08.2011 (Annexure P-1) and they were granted pay scale of ₹1200-2040 and LPA-782-2012 against the said judgment was dismissed on 01.05.2015 and the SLP(C)-19718-2015 was also dismissed on 23.11.2015. The petitioners, thereafter were granted arrear of salary pursuant to the directions given by this Court in COCP-1121-2012 vide office order dated 01.09.2012.

The petitioner was thereafter promoted to the post of ALM on 07.05.2002. He was granted 1st ACP w.e.f. 01.02.2002 in the un-revised pay scale of ₹2700-4400 and he was entitled for 2nd ACP after completion of 20 years of regular service as on 01.02.2012. His grievance is that 1st ACP has

not been granted as per revised pay scale and 2nd ACP has not been granted till date.

A detailed legal notice dated 22.06.2018 (Annexure P-8) has been sent to the respondents in this regard.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Deepak Manchanda, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is being disposed of by giving directions to the respondents to pass final order on the legal notice dated 22.06.2018 (Annexure P-8) claiming benefit of 1st and 2nd ACP in accordance with law within a period of four months and the respondents will inform the order passed to this Court.
