Through the present application, reply by way of affidavit of Dr. Anupma Malik, HCS, Estate Officer, HSVP, Karnal is sought to be placed on record.

Application is allowed. Reply is taken on record.

COCP No. 2346 of 2018

The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 15.01.2018 vide which a direction was issued to the respondents to pay compensation along with interest, solatium, additional due amount etc., in accordance with law within a period of three months with a further direction to pay ₹20,000/- as costs.

As per the aforesaid reply, ₹20,000/- as costs has since been paid to the petitioner by way of demand draft dated 14.01.2019 and further an amount of ₹13,448/- towards the compensation as per 5/136 share in the said khasra number has also been paid by way of cheque dated 14.11.2006.

It is further stated that the order was ex-parte and the petitioner did not

bring it to the notice of the Court that they have been paid the said compensation. Further the review application has also been filed against the order dated 15.01.2018 as the same was filed without taking into consideration that the compensation has since been passed.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stand discharged.

In case the petitioner is still aggrieved in any manner or there is any discrepancy in the amount so paid, he is at liberty to avail remedy as available to him, in accordance with law.
