The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of the order dated 26.07.2017, vide which, a direction was issued to the respondent to decide the legal notice of the petitioner by passing a speaking order.

The petitioner who is present in the Court states that the entire amount due to him has been paid except interest. The only order was to decide the legal notice. The legal notice has been decided, vide which, the petitioner has been entitled to the amount due to him. Admittedly, he has also given his receipt towards receiving the payment. There is no such direction for the interest.

In view of the same, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.

In case the petitioner is entitled to any interest, he is at liberty to avail remedy as available to him, in accordance with law for claiming the relief of interest.
