Present petition under Section 439 of the Criminal Procedure Code is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.93 dated 11.06.2017 under Section 15 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Division No.2, Pathankot.

Status report by way of affidavit of Prem Kumar, Deputy Superintendent of Police, City, Pathankot, filed on behalf of the respondent-State, is taken on record.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner submitted that he be allowed to withdraw the present petition for regular bail, but as the petitioner is in custody since 11.06.2017 and the trial has not been concluded as yet, some instructions be issued to learned trial Judge to conclude the trial within specified time schedule.

In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn. However, learned trial Judge is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously and preferably within a period of four months from today.
