AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 26.09.2016 passed by this Court in CWP No.21795 of 2014.

The relevant portion of the order is reproduced below:-

“Consequently, the present petition is allowed. Respondents are directed to compute the pension of the petitioners and release it to them from the above noted dates. Respondents shall also pay interest @ 9% per annum on the arrears of the pension. The necessary orders fixing the pension be passed within two months from the date of the receipt of a certified copy of the judgment and the amount be released immediately, thereafter, within 30 days.”

Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that pension has been released alongwith interest and calculation has been handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition. He seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law in case grievance survives with regard to calculation.

In view of above, contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
