This order shall dispose of four contempt petitions bearing COCN Nos.175, 176, 177 and 181 of 2019 as common question of law and facts are involved therein. However, the facts have been taken from COCN No.175 of 2019.

The contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of order dated 16.08.2018, vide which, writ petition was disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider the case of the petitioners as per judgment rendered in ***CWP No.3922 of 2011 titled as Narender Pal Singh Arya and another Vs. State of Haryana and others*** (wrongly written as *Narinder Kumar Arya and others Vs. State of Haryana and others*), decided on 03.10.2016.

Separate affidavit of Alok Nigam, Additional Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana filed in Court in all cases are taken on record. Copies given to learned counsel for the petitioners. As per the said affidavit, the judgment rendered in case of Narender Pal Singh Arya (supra) challenged before the Hon'ble Apex Court and vide order dated 06.05.2019, the Hon'ble Apex Court has stayed the operation of the judgment and order

passed by this Court.

In view of the same, no contempt is made out at this stage. The same are dismissed accordingly.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

The petitioners are at liberty to file afresh in case the SLP is decided in their favour.
