Learned counsel for State on instructions from Mr.Sandeep Kumar, Senior Assistant, O/o Director Health Punjab submits that the payment to all the petitioners have been made except petitioners No. 12 and 13. With regard to petitioner No.13, it is submitted that the bills have been sent to the Treasury and the amount would be credited to his account within two weeks from today.

It is contended that petitioner No.12 expired and no representation was received from the LR's and in case same is made, it would be dealt with expeditiously.

In view of above, the contempt petition is disposed of.

However, it is made clear that in case the statement made today in Court is found factually wrong, the petitioners would be at liberty revive the contempt petition.

Mr.Sandeep Kumar, Senior Assistant, who has given aforesaid instructions states that in case the statement is found factually wrong, he is ready to bear the costs which he would pay in person.

Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks liberty to avail remedy in case aggrieved of the calculation of the amount.
