The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 8.11.2017.

Sh. Narpinder Singh, District Development and Panchayat Officer, Sangrur is present in Court and has filed affidavit dated 24.4.2019 stating therein that the order has been complied with and the correction of the entries in the revenue record has been carried out. He also brought a demand draft of ₹ 5,000/- in the name of the petitioner.

However, since no one has appeared for the petitioner, the said demand draft be given to the petitioner and the receipt of the same be placed on record within two weeks.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

However, in case, the correction is not carried out in the revenue record, the petitioner will be at liberty to revive the contempt

petition. Further, in case the receipt of the demand draft is not placed, the

contempt petition be listed after the the expiry of two weeks.
