Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the needful for the compliance of the directions of this Court has been done i.e. reinstatement of the petitioner and payment of 50% back wages. However, she submits that consequential relief flowing from the litigation i.e. the services of the petitioner had to be regularized at par with his juniors has not been granted. She seeks liberty to avail remedy for the redressal of the said grievance, in accordance with law.
