This contempt petition has been filed pleading willful disobedience of the order dated 19.01.2018 passed in CWP No. 968 of 2018. The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

*“Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and considering the observations made in the order of this Court dated 23.01.2014 passed in CWP No.1171 of 2014 (**Surjit Singh and others versus State of Haryana and others**), the instant writ petition is disposed of in the same terms. Let an appropriate decision be taken by the Competent Authority within a period of four months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order. “*

On notice, respondent No.1 has filed a short reply by way of affidavit of Nirmal Dahiya, Land Acquisition Collector, Urban Estate, Rohtak, alongwith Annexure R-1. The same is taken on record.

In view of the above, the order of this Court has been complied with, no further order is required to be passed in contempt petition.

Disposed of as infructuous. The rule issued against the respondents is hereby discharged.

However, in case the petitioner feels aggrieved of the order passed by the authorities, he would be at liberty to avail remedies as are available in accordance with law.
