The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C because the trial Court has cancelled his bail vide order dated 17.12.2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was on regular bail and was diligently attending the trial. However, on 17.12.2018, due to mis-communication with his counsel, he failed to appear and therefore, the trial Court has cancelled the regular bail granted to him. The absence was unintentional and the petitioner is willing to surrender before the trial Court.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to issue notice to the respondent.

The petition is disposed of with direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court on the next date of hearing i.e. 18.1.2019 and move an application for regular bail. On his doing so, the trial Court shall grant him regular bail subject to its satisfaction.
