The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 23.03.2017 passed in CWP No. 14825 of 2014.

Learned State counsel has placed on record a photocopy of invoice No. 0100115419072914 and pay order No. 0100116961, same are taken on record and copy handed over to the counsel for the petitioner.

In view of above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law in case there is a dispute with regard to the calculations of the amount due.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

On 18.07.2019, Director Health, submitted before this Court that an inquiry would be made with regard to the defaulting official for whose in action

the delay had occurred. Dr. Suraj Bhan Kamboj, Director Health, who is present in Court submits that he is not disputing the fact that in spite of LPA being pending in this Court, the order has been complied with now almost after 2 ½ years and that too subject to the outcome of LPA, the said action could have been done earlier also.

He further states that the matter is being enquired into and necessary action would be taken against the erring official in accordance with law and compliance report in this regard would be furnished before this Court within three months from today.
