The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner in case First Information Report No. 90 dated 25.02.2018, under Sections 306/34 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station City Dabwali, District Sirsa.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 01.05.2018 and there are total 17 prosecution witnesses, but only 7 have been examined till date, thus the trial is likely to take long time, hence, she be enlarged on bail. Also contends that all the three family members i.e. the petitioner, her son and daughter are in custody.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate of the petitioner in the Court today, the same is taken on record. Perusal of the custody certificate reveals that there is no other criminal case pending

against the petitioner. He acknowledged the above factual position regarding custody, number of prosecution witnesses and status of trial.

Since the petitioner is a female and she is in custody since 01.05.2018. There is no other criminal case pending against her. Therefore, further incarceration will not serve any purpose, rather that will be detrimental to her at this stage. The trial is likely to take a long time to be concluded, therefore, in view of the abovesaid circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is accepted. Petitioner-Sumitra be admitted to bail on her furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
