Short reply by way of affidavit by Indu Malhotra, Director Public Instructions (Colleges) Punjab dated 11.4.2019 filed in Court is taken on record. As per the same, the claim of the petitioner for protection of pay has been admitted and re-fixed. The same has been sent to the Treasury. It is further stated that the same shall be deposited in the account of the petitioner within six weeks from today.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stand discharged.

However, in case there is any discrepancy in the amount, the petitioner is at liberty to file representation, which shall be decided in accordance with law. In case, the said amount is not deposited in the account of the petitioner with the stipulated period as mentioned above, the petitioner will be at liberty to revive the present contempt petition.
