ANIL KSHETARPAL, J.

The plaintiff-petitioner is in the revision petition against the order passed by the learned trial court, dismissing the application for appointment of local commissioner to demarcate the area.

The learned trial court has found that the plaintiff wants the Court to collect evidence on his behalf, which is not permissible.

It has been held by Division Benches of this Court in *Harvinder Kaur and another Vs. Godharam and another, 1979 PLJ 562* and *Pritam Singh and others Vs. Sunder Lal and others, 1990 (2) PLR 191* that the revision petition against the order passed by the learned trial court, dismissing the application for appointment of local commissioner, is not maintainable.

Still further, plaintiff is in the process of leading his evidence and he can very well lead the evidence to prove the assertions made in the plaint. Hence, no ground is made out to interfere.

The Civil Revision Petition is dismissed.
