AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (ORAL)

Learned State counsel submits that in compliance of the directions issued by this Court vide order dated 11.12.2013 passed in CWP No. 27247 of 2013 a supplementary award has been passed and the same would be communicated to the petitioner within three weeks from today.

In view of above, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that no cause of action survives for pursuing the present petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedy against the supplementary award.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

It is clarified that in case the copy of the supplementary award is not supplied either to the petitioners or to their counsel within three weeks from today, petitioners would be at liberty to revive the present petition. In case

petitioners are forced to revive the present petition, costs of ₹50,000/- would be imposed and it would be recoverable personally from the defaulting official/officer.
