This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 24.5.2012 passed in CWP No. 10047 of 2012.

This Court issued direction to respondent No.2 (in the writ petition) to decide the demand notice dated 10.1.2012, by passing a speaking order. The issue involved in the demand notice was pending in the SLP preferred by the respondent. The petitioners were informed that their claim cannot be decided in view of the pending SLP. The SLP was dismissed on 18.8.2017. Thereafter, the petitioners moved another representation to the respondent for decision on demand notice as the SLP has been dismissed. The only grievance is that the decision has not been taken till date.

Today, order dated 13.8.2019 has been produced in Court, copy handed over to petitioner No. 1, who is present in person.

As per the said order, the claim made by petitioners in the demand notice has been rejected. On 22.4.2019, costs were imposed on the respondent for not filing the reply. A demand draft of ₹5000/- has been handed over to petitioner No.1 today in Court in lieu of costs imposed by this Court.

In view of the order passed, no further cause of action survives for the petitioners to pursue the present contempt petition. However, they are at liberty to pursue their remedy in accordance with law against the order dated 13.8.2019.

Disposed of.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
